FLORISTRY GUIDELINES

We highly recommend working with a florist from our Preferred Supplier List. All of our chosen florists have been through an extensive vetting process and have become experts at understanding the particular look, feel and space of Hedsor House.

Our preferred florists will be able to help you get the most out of your budget and recommend creative options for your special day.

NON-PREFERRED FLORISTS

Should you wish to choose a floral designer who isn't on our list, please review these guidelines and pass them on to the florist you are considering.

Access to Hedsor for set-up is from 10:30am.

It is the responsibility of the florist to light candles and move arrangements unless otherwise arranged, for example moving floral arches after the ceremony.

We ask that all floral arrangements be broken down at the end of the wedding and removed by the florist **that night.** Our Games Room can be used for couples who wish to take some or all of their displays with them the following day. Any unwanted displays must be taken and disposed of off-site.

Unfortunately, we cannot allow rose petals or confetti inside Hedsor or on the front drive unless in an enclosed vase, lantern or container. Streamer wands, outdoor bubbles and outdoor sparklers are beautiful alternatives to a confetti walk. We will allow biodegradable or organic confetti to be thrown in the long grass on our South Lawn only.

Lots of floral arrangements incorporate candles, particularly for the wedding breakfast. We have a separate candle guide which may be requested from your Wedding Specialist.
