OUTDOOR CEREMONIES

Hedsor is licenced for legal wedding ceremonies to take place outside. We have two beautiful options for your outdoor ceremony, either on our South Terrace, or on the open plain of the South Lawn.

If you would like to hold your ceremony outside, you will need to inform your registrars, caterers, florist and your Hedsor Wedding Specialist. Some caterers may charge an additional setup fee for an outdoor ceremony. Any ceremony at Hedsor House is also subject to our Ceremony Facility Fee of £450 + VAT in 2024 or £495 + VAT in 2025.

As there may be additional noise outdoors, you may wish to consider the use of a PA system for the spoken parts of the ceremony. Your production company will be able to advise you and arrange this.

We always advise to prepare for inclement weather, and would ask that you let us know your wet weather ceremony plan. This usually means moving the ceremony indoors to our Centre Hall. The registrars will have the final say on whether your ceremony can take place outdoors. The final decision will be made early on the day once the weather forecast has been checked.

Outdoor ceremonies will have use of the Chiavari chairs only, and may be set up with four seats on either side of the aisle with a maximum of 19 rows (this arrangement will seat 150 guests) on the South Terrace.
